ENRIQUE GINZBURG

Dr. Enrique Ginzburg received his medical degree from the University of Miami School of Medicine. He completed a Fellowship in Vascular Surgery at the Vascular Surgeons of Central Ohio and a Residency at the University of Miami/Jackson Memorial Medical Center.

Dr. Ginzburg is currently Professor of Surgery, Division of Trauma and Surgical Critical Care at the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine. In addition, Dr. Ginzburg holds secondary appointments with the departments of Anesthesia, Neurological Surgery and Family Medicine.

Dr. Ginzburg was the coordinator of the affiliation between the University of Miami and the University of Tel Aviv. He was also the founding coordinator of the Trauma Training Program for the Middle East. This program is responsible for training 90% of the trauma trained surgeons in the State of Israel. He also was appointed Honorary Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Army after helping to found the United States Army Training Program at Jackson Memorial Hospital which provides training to all medical personnel deployed to Iraq.

Currently, Dr. Ginzburg is Medical Director of the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine International Health Center and the International Director of CEDECEM, an organization developing the trauma delivery system for Argentina.

Following the earthquake in Haiti on January 12, 2010, Dr. Ginzburg was one of the first responders to arrive in Haiti and currently serves as the Chief Medical Officer for the University of Miami Global Institute / Project MediShare.

Dr. Ginzburg has been published extensively on a variety of topics in Journals such as American Surgery, Journal of American College of Surgery, Journal of Trauma. Dr. Ginzburg is also an active member of various professional organizations such as American Association for the Surgery of Trauma and American College of Surgeons.
